Although it is relatively simple to calculate a weighted average quality for any grower who delivered to CBH at the completion of harvest, growers would benefit from live calculations during harvest that allow for offsetting individual loads not meeting a certain receive standard against a quality bank of loads within the receive standards. This will allow a grower to improve the grading of one load against another load.

The primary task of SolveIT's optimisation platform will be to power the CBH web application for quality optimisation. SolveIT's Optimisation Platform will receive selected grower data including load information, prices, optimisation objective, etc. and generate optimal lot plans. The grower will see the results of the optimiser displayed through the CBH web application, where they will be able to make manual adjustments, as well as accept and submit a plan.

"Our growers spend an enormous amount of time physically blending grain on farm, the Quality Optimisation system is all about giving control and flexibility to our growers so that they can virtually perform this blending function, we, along with SolveIT are providing them the tools they need to optimally perform this virtual function," said Mr Mathew Regan, Grain Quality Manager, CBH Group. "We believe that SolveIT's platform is most suited to providing fast and accurate results to enhance our grower members business."
